JUDGES 6-8

verses	what <i>fear</i> does	what <i>faith</i> does	what <i>pride</i> does
Judges 6:11-12, 14-16	makes us hide and doubt what we can do	tells us that God knows who we are and what we can do	
Judges 6:17, 22-24	makes us doubt God, question God, and afraid of God	reminds us that God is with us and His will is not to harm us	
Judges 6:27	tells us to do God's work in secret	tells us God is with us and we have no need to hide	
Judges 7:1-8	tells us that we need more	tells us God is all we need	
Judges 7:12	make us believe it's too much and too big	tells us God is bigger	
Judges 7:16	tells us that plan is crazy and won't work	reminds us that God can do great things with anything	
Judges 7:19-22		reminds us that when we obey God, things turn out better	
Judges 7:20		gives God the credit	gives us the credit too
Judges 7:24-25		tells us that God will fight our battles	tells us that we need to fight the battles
Judges 8:7-9		does only what God says to do	causes us to do more than we should do
Judges 8:16-21		tells that vengeance belongs to the Lord	causes us to take matters into our own hands
Judges 8:22-26		tells us that the Lord should rule over	tells us to take what belongs to God
Judges 8:27		tells us to worship God	tells us to worship ourselves
Judges 8:33-34		remembers God and all He has done for His people	forgets God and goes back to old ways
